



### An Effigy of Eschatological Conjectures

- 1) The \_\_\_\_\_ Defined
  - a) The moment when \_\_\_\_\_ will come for all who have personally trusted Him as their Saviour – both living and the dead. These saints will go with Him back up to heaven. This could occur at any moment. (John 14:1-3; 1 Cor. 15:50-58; 1 Thes. 4:13-18)
- 2) The \_\_\_\_\_ Explained
  - a) A seven year period beginning after the rapture when a peace treaty between \_\_\_\_\_ and the Antichrist is established. During this time the Lord will pour out His wrath upon the earth in successive waves of Judgment. (Rev. 6; 8:1 = seal judgments; Rev. 8, 9, 11:15-19 = trumpet judgments; Rev. 16 = bowl judgments)
  - b) In his prophecy of the 70 weeks or 490 years, Daniel said the Tribulation would be “one week” and uses the Hebrew word designating a week of \_\_\_\_\_, or seven years. The first 69 weeks of years, started with the decree of Artaxerxes to restore the walls of Jerusalem. It ended with the rejection of Jesus. It was 483 years (69 weeks of years). The tribulation (final week) will be 7 years. (Dan. 9:24-27)
  - c) Israel has been on prophetic “\_\_\_\_\_” for almost 2,000 years, but someday it will go through that final 7-year period.
- 3) The \_\_\_\_\_ Revealed
  - a) The Antichrist will rule the world politically, economically, and religiously. The entire world will give allegiance to him or suffer persecution and death. (Rev. 13:5-18)
  - b) 7,8,14,15 = one world \_\_\_\_\_
  - c) 16 = one world \_\_\_\_\_
  - d) 17 = one world \_\_\_\_\_
- 4) Armageddon Defined
  - a) The final event of the Great Tribulation when all the armies of the earth gather to come against \_\_\_\_\_ and attempt once and for all to eradicate the Jewish people. (Rev. 16:12-16; Rev. 19:11-21)
- 5) The \_\_\_\_\_ Appearing
  - a) The climactic event of human history is the literal, physical, visible, glorious return of Jesus Christ back to earth to destroy the armies of the world, which are gathered in Israel, and to set up His kingdom on earth. (Rev. 19:11-16)
- 6) The \_\_\_\_\_ Year Reign on Earth
  - a) After the glorious appearing of Christ, Satan will be bound and imprisoned in the bottomless pit for 1,000 years. (Rev. 20:1-3)
  - b) This 1,000 year period is often called the Millennium.
